The Catholic Church had elected the first black Cardinal. Talk about systemic racism. The Catholic Church accepted gays, before they accepted Blacks. We already had our first black president and they are just now getting the first black Cardinal. What about a black pope? You'll probably have to wait another 2000 years before you get a black pope. Because the scribes and Pharisees, think their sins are forgiven. Because they think they are covered by their good works. And they may very well be. Only God knows.

This is why all the men of the Bible were very humble. Although God's 10 Commandments was written in stone, they take the I don't know, only God knows approach. So when God says to Ezekiel, "can these dry bones live" Ezekiel answers, "Lord only you know". You won't get this humbleness with modern-day preachers. They seem to tell you what God will and won't do. God's will, is more about love, then it is logic or reason. Love seems to have nothing to do with logic or reason. Everything God tells Abraham to do, is a love test. If you love me, you will do the things I say. God said the world is like a contest. To see who will be saved. God puts before men life and death and they get to choose. Although they shouldn't get to choose it for their children, that's why I don't believe in abortion. And he says verily I say to you, except you be converted and become as little children, you shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven. In verse four he continues, whoever therefore shall humble himself as the little child, the same is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. Now you are probably expecting Jesus to say I'm the Savior, I'm the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. I'm sure that's the answer every Christian and Catholic will give. But read the chapter and stop listening to the Christian and Catholic cardinals who took 2000 years to decide if a black man should be a cardinal.

Then Jesus says in verse five, who so receive one such little child in my name, receives me. But who so offend one of these little ones, which believe in me, it would be better for him that a millstone were hanged around his neck and that he was drowned in the depth of the sea. Whoever shall humble himself as this little child, the same is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.
